

NOTICE OF NOMINATION

Public Notice is given to the electors of the District of North Vancouver that nominations for the office of:

Mayor	one to be elected
Councillor	six to be elected
School Trustee	four to be elected

for a four-year term ending in November 2030 will be received by the Chief Election Officer or a designated person as follows:

- When:** Beginning at 9:00am on Tuesday, Sept. 1, 2026 and ending at 4:00pm on Friday, Sept. 11, 2026 (excluding holidays and weekends)
- Where:** Legislative Services, District of North Vancouver, 355 West Queens Road, North Vancouver, BC V7N 4N5
- How:** Interested persons can now obtain information on the requirements and procedures for making nominations, including nominations forms, at **DNV.org/vote**, the District of North Vancouver Municipal Hall during regular office hours (8:00am–4:30pm) or by email at elections@dnv.org.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office if they meet the following requirements:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and,
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act*, *School Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local elections, the following expense limit for candidates apply during the campaign period from Sept. 19 to Oct. 17, 2026:

Mayor	\$74,638.67
Councillor	\$37,829.81
School Trustee	\$39,353.28

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2026 general local election, the following third party advertising limits apply during the campaign period from Sept. 19 to Oct. 17, 2026:

Mayor and Councillor	\$3,731.93
School Trustee	\$2,424.91

LIST OF REGISTERED ELECTORS

Beginning Sept. 1, 2026 until the close of general voting for the election on Oct. 17, 2026, a copy of the list of registered electors will, upon signature, be available for public inspection at the District of North Vancouver Municipal Hall during regular office hours (8:00am–4:30pm) and on general voting day **by appointment only** by contacting the Chief Election Officer at elections@dnv.org or 604-990-2212.

REQUEST TO OMIT OR OBSCURE PERSONAL INFORMATION

An elector may request that their address or other information about them be omitted from, or obscured on, the list of electors. Upon request, the Chief Election Officer will amend the list available to the public and candidates by omitting or obscuring the elector's information.

OBJECTION TO REGISTRATION OF AN ELECTOR

An objection to the registration of a person whose name appears on the list of registered electors may be made in accordance with the *Local Government Act* until 4:00pm on Sept. 11, 2026. An objection must be in writing and may only be made by a person entitled to be registered as an elector of the District of North Vancouver and can only be made on the basis that a person whose name appears on the list of electors has died or that a person whose name appears on the list of electors is not qualified to be registered as an elector of the District of North Vancouver.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Mail ballot voting is available to all voters who meet the elector qualifications.

Apply for a mail ballot:

- Online at **DNV.org/vote**
- In person at District Municipal Hall (Monday to Friday, 8:00am–4:30pm, excluding statutory holidays)

To allow enough time for your ballot to be mailed to you, please submit your application by Sept. 23, 2026.

You can return your completed ballot:

- By mail, or
- By depositing it in the mail slot at District Municipal Hall, 355 West Queens Road, North Vancouver

To be counted, completed mail ballots must be received by the Chief Election Officer at District Municipal Hall no later than the close of voting on General Voting Day ending at 8:00pm on Saturday, Oct. 17, 2026.
